- Phase 1 Study Technical Report (Late 2006)
- EIR/EIS Phase (Began Fall 2008)
 - Sheldon/Wilton Community Workshops (Spring 2009)
 - Agency reviews and scoping (Summer 2009)
 - Notice of Preparation (NOP/NOI) (Summer 2009)
 - Final Alternatives development (Summer 2009- Spring 2010)
 - Technical studies (Summer 2009 - Spring 2010)
 - Draft Environmental Document (Winter 2010)
 - Final Environmental Document (Winter 2011)

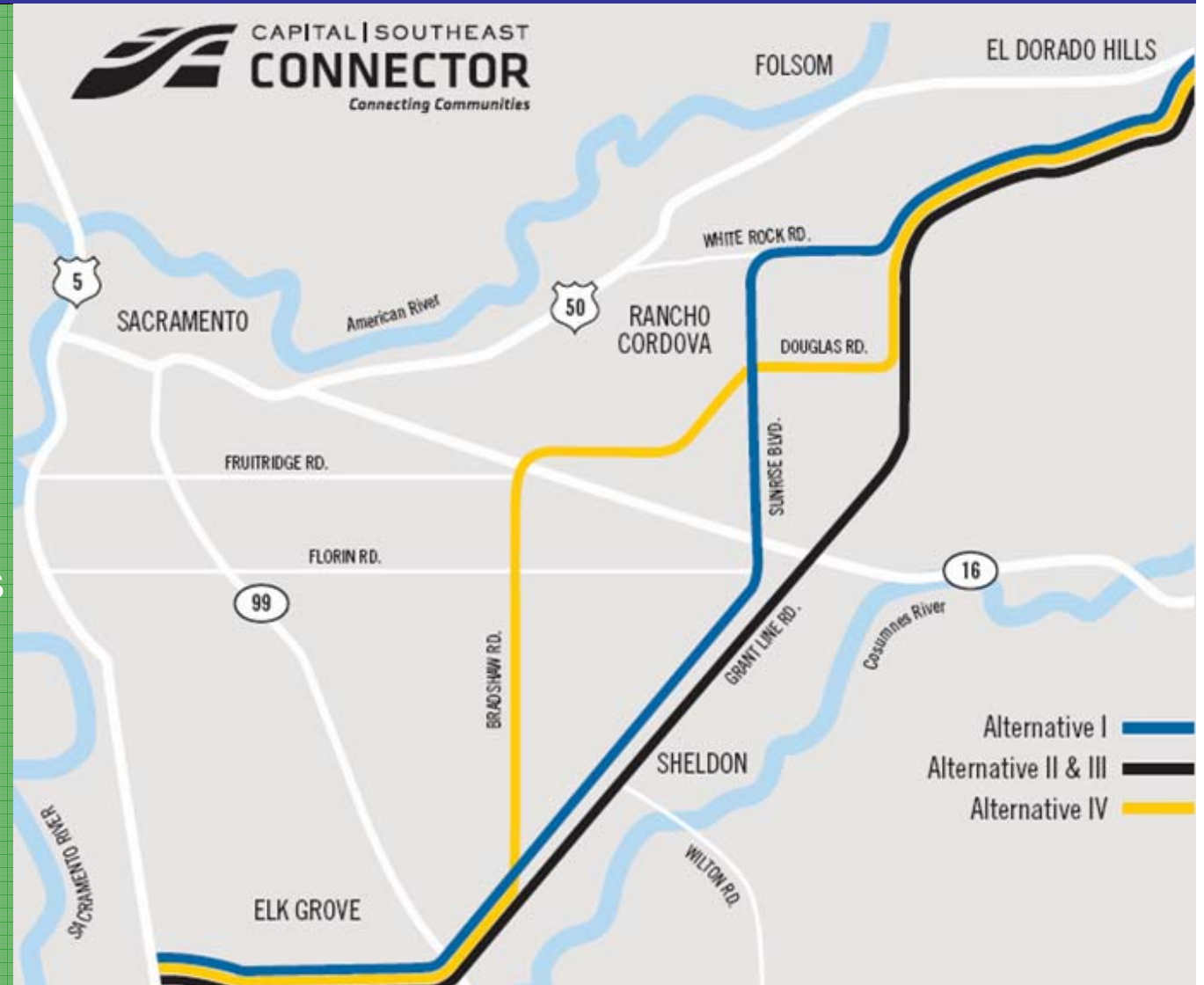
Phase 1 SACOG Alternatives

 - Development of four alternative alignments, with three options in Sheldon Area
 - Additional Alignments discussed during Public Outreach Meetings
 - Four by-pass alignments between Deer Creek/Cosumnes River
 - Widening of Dillard Road, Wilton Road and Sunrise
