



## Sheldon-Wilton Community Meeting Tuesday, October 6, 2009

- Community input on Sheldon-Wilton area alternatives is actively sought early in the environmental process. Formal community scoping meetings are planned for early in 2010. - Project Need:
  - **Mobility:** Improve access to, and connections between, residential and employment areas
  - **Land Use:** Preserve open space and habitat that may be threatened as the region develops
- Project Purpose:
  - Minimize impacts to communities along the project corridor
  - Provide efficient, multi-modal transportation options
  - Serve and support planned growth
  - Improve access to existing and planned job centers
  - Facilitate goods movement
  - Preserve open space, wildlife habitat and agricultural uses
  - Incorporate sustainable design principles
- Four Connector alignment alternatives are currently under consideration
- Three Sheldon-Wilton alignment alternatives are under consideration:
  - Community-based No Build
  - Bypass
  - Four-lane Grant Line Road with community preservation measures
- Next Steps:
  - Develop staff recommendations
  - Review recommendations with Sheldon-Wilton Community Working Group
  - Present staff report to JPA Board at October 23 meeting
