PUBLIC NOTICE

The Notice of Preparation (NOP) for the Capital SouthEast Connector Program Environmental Impact Report (EIR) has been issued. We would like your views on issues that may be of concern to you. The Capital South-East Connector, is a major transportation project proposing a 35-mile roadway spanning from Interstate 5, south of Elk Grove, to Hwy 50 in El Dorado County, just east of El Dorado Hills. The Notice of Preparation has been sent to responsible agencies and involved federal agencies pursuant to Section 15082 of the CEQA Guidelines.
